## Regulations for the Establishment of Bilingual University Promotion

## Committee of College of Medicine and College of Medical Science and

## **Technology at I-Shou University**

Adopted by the College Affairs Council on December 6, 2021, and promulgated with the consent from the President dated on December 12, 2021

- Article 1 The college-level Bilingual University Promotion Committee (hereinafter referred to as "the Committee") is established jointly by the College of Medicine and the College of Medical Science and Technology (hereinafter referred to as "the Colleges") with the aim of facilitating and practicing bilingual education, improving students' English skills in listening, speaking, reading, and writing and faculty members' EMI skills, and broadening students and faculty members' international perspectives.
- Article 2 The Committee is responsible for:
  - 1. deliberating and facilitating bilingual education programs;
  - 2. reviewing the budget for bilingual education programs;
  - 3. implementing and monitoring bilingual education programs and compiling performance reports; and
  - 4. handling other affairs in relation to bilingual education programs.
- Article 3 The Committee is comprised of several members, including the Deans and the Associate Deans of the Colleges and the chairs of the departments/programs under the Colleges. The Deans of the Colleges shall serve as the chairperson and the vice chairperson, respectively, while both of the Associate Deans of the Colleges shall serve as executive secretaries.
- Article 4 Committee members shall meet at least once every semester, and an extraordinary session may be called whenever necessary. Scholars and experts from within or outside I-Shou University may be invited to committee meetings as participants without the power to vote.
- Article 5 The Dean's Offices of the Colleges are jointly responsible for administrative affairs relating to the Committee.
- Article 6 The Regulations become effective on the third day of promulgation after being adopted by the College Affairs Council and ratified by the President.

Note: In the event of any dispute or misunderstanding as to the interpretation of the language or terms of the Regulations, the Chinese language version shall prevail.
