## Regulations for the Establishment of Collegiate Committee on Interdisciplinary and Innovative Development of College of Medicine at I-Shou University

Adopted by the College Affairs Council on December 6, 2021, and promulgated with the consent from the President dated on December 12, 2021

- Article 1 The Regulations for the Establishment of Collegiate Committee on Interdisciplinary and Innovative Development of College of Medicine at I-Shou University (hereinafter referred to as "the Regulations") are made by the College of Medicine (hereinafter referred to as "the College") to form the Collegiate Committee on Interdisciplinary and Innovative Development (hereinafter referred to as "the Committee") to shoulder the responsibility for planning and facilitating the interdisciplinary and innovative development of collegiate affairs and improving the quality of teaching at the College.
- Article 2 The Committee is responsible for:
  - deliberating the interdisciplinary and innovative development of the College;
     and
  - 2. deliberating any other issues relating to the interdisciplinary and innovative development of the College.
- Article 3 The Dean of the College shall serve as the convener and chairperson of the Committee, and the chairs of departments (directors of institutes and programs) of the College are ex-officio members of the Committee. One full-time or project faculty member from each of the subordinate departments (institutes and programs) shall be selected to serve as an elected member. Committee members shall serve a one-year term and may be reappointed.
- Article 4 The Committee meets at least once every academic year. Extraordinary sessions may be convened if necessary. Experts or specialists from within or outside I-Shou University may be invited to committee meetings for an exchange of views as participants without the power to vote.
- Article 5 A quorum of at least half of the total membership will be required to validate a committee meeting, and consent from at least half of the members attending is required for resolutions.

- Article 6 Matters not mentioned herein, if any, shall be subject to the applicable regulations and rules of I-Shou University.
- Article 7 The Regulations become effective on the third day of promulgation after being adopted by the College Affairs Council and ratified by the President.

Note: In the event of any dispute or misunderstanding as to the interpretation of the language or terms of the Regulations, the Chinese language version shall prevail.
